## Camping and Recreation

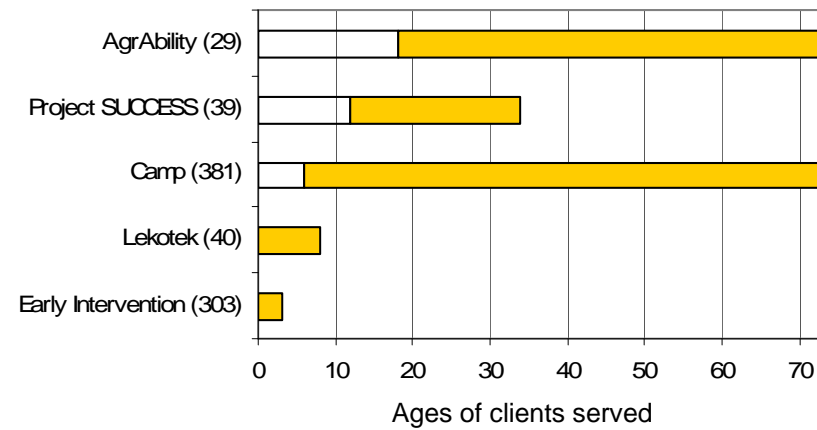
Residential camping for children and adults with disabilities as well as therapeutic specialty camps and respite services.

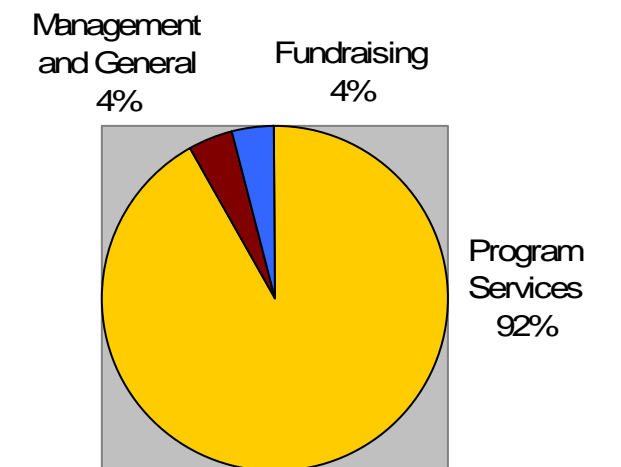
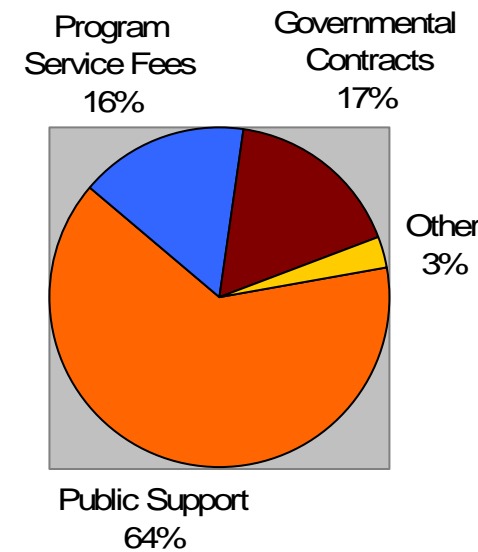
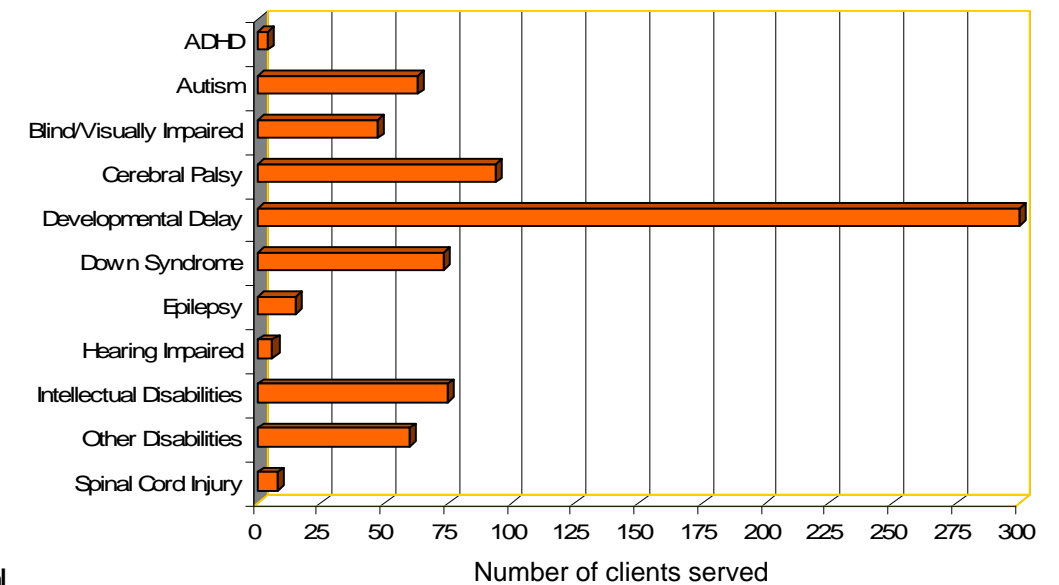
